## NEWSLETTER SPRING 2020







The Treasurer reported a successful year with a surplus of £1188 recorded. In addition to membership fees, we raised £1058 from fund raising events and received a welcome grant from Shaftesbury Town Council. The year end balance of £4156 leaves us in good stead for this years' events and the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Twinning with Lindlar in 2021. The same Committee was proposed and re-elected with addition of Antonia Eastman. The evening closed with a "Pot Luck" buffet supper and was enjoyed by all.

<u>Corona Virus</u> – The Brexit Transition period that commenced in January has been overshadowed by the global spread of this virus. We remain committed to Twinning events both at home and in France or Germany, but sadly The Lindlar visit has now been cancelled.
