AGM - Our AGM was due to take place on Friday 26th February 2021, but as with all our committee and social meetings "Cancelled due to Covid 19 restrictions". Please find attached our Vice Chair's and Treasurers report for the year.

<u>Chairmans report.</u> Our Chairman Simon Pritchard decided to stand down, but remains a member of Twinning. From a Twinning point of view it has been a very quiet year with little to report. Members have individually kept in contact with friends in Lindlar and Brionne, but there has been no meeting or events to arrange or attend. We wish you all well and hope that we can return to some normality later this year. Best wishes to our friends in Brionne and Lindlar also.

SHAFTESBURY TOWN TWINNING ASSOCIATION FINANCIAL REPORT Y/E 31 DEC 2020

Shaftesbury Town Twinning Association recorded a surplus of £97 in what proved to be a very curtailed 2020 programme with all activities suspended from mid March owing to the Corona virus pandemic. Subscriptions, however, increased to £280-00 (2019-£266) whilst in January we held a very successful Quiz Night which recorded a surplus of £333,

Expenditure was in consequence restricted although we renewed our website domain covering 5 years. A deposit of £100 was paid to The Royal Chase Hotel for dinner with our German visitors from Lindlar in May 2020 and has been transferred to 2021 when we hope our friends from Germany will be able to visit us. We also benefitted from a discount on our insurance premium owing to reduced activities.

With interest rates declining – our deposit account with Lloyds TSB was earning 0.05% - Committee approved the opening of a Charity Account with the Bath Building Society through their local agency at Chaffers, Shaftesbury, by transferring £2000 from the Lloyds TSB account. The interest rate at the time of opening was 0.75% although in common with other accounts has declined since then.

Given that the Association has £4156 in the bank, and we have been unable to carry out any activities since March 2021, it is recommended that we do not charge any subscriptions for 2021.

<u>Corona Virus</u> – The vaccination programme is well underway and many of the over 50's have now had their first injection. Old and New members are welcome to join us as soon as things resume and we are allowed to meet again. There will be no request for payment of Membership fees until February 2022.
